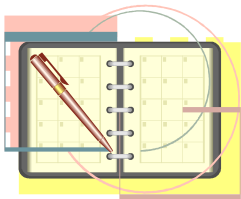
November 16, 2010 at RCSS:

President Holly called the meeting to order at 12:45 pm. We were pleased to have one visiting Rotarian, Jack Ezelle, from the Savannah Downtown Rotary Club. Our guests were Brian Purtell (Gayheart), Andy Brodmann (Peyton), Francine Wright (Hazel), and Gray Tinsley (Eskew). President Holly filled in as finer today and collected \$70 for the Rotary Foundation with some Extreme Makeover trivia.

Don Stubbs introduced Carl and Maria from the Savannah East Rotary Club who spoke with us about Savannah East's upcoming fundraiser – Lip-a-licious for Literacy. The event will take place on Saturday, December 4th at the new library located next to the Savannah Mall and benefit the Summer Reading Program. Illiteracy costs business owners 7 billion each year. The summer reading program is a stepping stone to reach the children of Savannah to keep their brains active during summer vacation. Only 28% of Georgia's fourth graders read at proficiency level. With the Live Oak Library's primary funding source being the state, their budget has been cut \$30K. Lip-a-Licious hopes to raise \$10K to help with the funding shortfall. The event will feature a runway style auction of ladies lipsticks modeled by such people as Tinkerbell (whom will be our GRSP Student Mia), Cat Woman (see right), Lawrence of Arabia, and many more literary figures! Also on the auction block will be a kimono donated from a Rotary Club in Tokyo. Tickets are only \$40. Another exciting announcement was that our own George Hubbs has volunteered to match 50% of financial donations to the Live Oak Library Foundation up to \$10,000 each year for the next 3 years! Way to go George!



With no further business, President Holly wished everyone a wonderful Thanksgiving and the meeting was closed with the 4-Way Test.

For most categories of attendees, the base price for the convention is US\$300. Registration for a pre-convention event will entail an additional fee; however, you no longer need to register for the convention in order to register for a pre-convention event.

December 15th is the first registration deadline. For most attendees, the convention registration cost increases to \$340 after this time. March 31st is the second registration deadline. After this time, the convention registration cost increases to \$380.

The deadline for canceling registration and tickets is April 15th, and May 6th is the deadline for online registration.

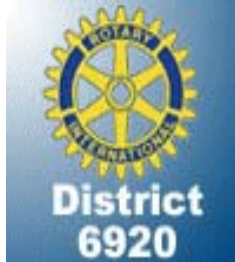

What is Rotary?

Rotary International is a volunteer organization of business and professional leaders who provide humanitarian service, and help to build goodwill and peace in the world.

There are approximately 1.2 million Rotary club members belonging to nearly 33,000 Rotary clubs in more than 200 countries and geographical areas.

Founded in Chicago in 1905, Rotary celebrated 100 years of service in 2005.

The Rotary Foundation has awarded more than US\$1.9 billion in grants, which are administered at the local level by Rotary clubs.

The Object of Rotary

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

- First: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;
- Second: High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying by each Rotarian of his or her occupation as an opportunity to serve society;
- Third. The application of the ideal of service by every Rotarian to his or her personal, business and community life;
- Fourth. The advancement of international understanding, good will, and peace through a world of fellowship of business and professional people united in the ideal of service.
