Jerry Thomas had the pleasure of presenting Hurley Cook with a Paul Harris Fellow +3 certificate. Thanks for your incredible support Hurley!

Our speakers today were our very own PDG Kenan Kern & Mikell Cates. Kenan opened the presentation with a brief overview of the upcoming 2011 Rotary International Convention, which will be held in New Orleans, Louisiana. A short film about New Orleans was shown to the club. As part of the 2011 Rotary International Conversation, our Club member, Mike Cates, will have a booth to promote the "lite box." The "lite box" is a lighting/communications device that could potentially be used in conjunction with the shelter boxes. Mike is currently in the process of patenting the device. He plans to give the patent to the Rotary Club of Savannah South in hopes of producing the boxes as a fundraising source for our club. Like the shelter boxes, if the "lite box" was successful, it could potentially generate substantial funds for our Club. The "lite box" would include the following:

- 1) 25-35 watt panel
- 2) Mounting hardware
- 3) 6ft galvanized post
- 4) Charge controller
- 5) DC to AC inverter
- 6) 3 LED lights
- 7) Cables
- 8) Compass
- 9) Instructions (in several languages)
- 10) Electrical tape

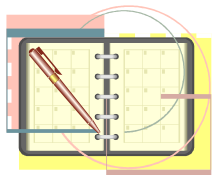

Mikell fielded several questions from the club regarding the box and it's advantages. The meeting was adjourned by Mat Turner at 1:29 pm.



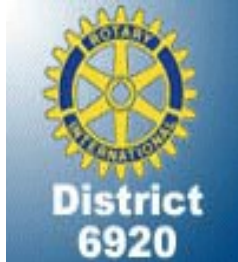

What is Rotary?

Rotary International is a volunteer organization of business and professional leaders who provide humanitarian service, and help to build goodwill and peace in the world.

There are approximately 1.2 million Rotary club members belonging to nearly 33,000 Rotary clubs in more than 200 countries and geographical areas.

Founded in Chicago in 1905, Rotary celebrated 100 years of service in 2005.

The Rotary Foundation has awarded more than US\$1.9 billion in grants, which are administered at the local level by Rotary clubs.

The Object of Rotary

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

- First: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;
- Second: High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying by each Rotarian of his or her occupation as an opportunity to serve society;
- Third. The application of the ideal of service by every Rotarian to his or her personal, business and community life;
- Fourth. The advancement of international understanding, good will, and peace through a world of fellowship of business and professional people united in the ideal of service.
